RELATING TO HEALTH CARE; REQUIRING THAT CERTAIN HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS THAT PROVIDE SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT GIVE PRIORITY TO PREGNANT WOMEN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

- SECTION 1. SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT--SERVICES FOR PREGNANT WOMEN.--
- A. A health care provider that provides substance abuse treatment to women shall offer:
- (1) to pregnant women the same services it offers to the general population of women, unless offering those services is otherwise medically indicated; and
- (2) treatment to pregnant women at the earliest reasonable opportunity after the pregnant woman requests or is referred to substance abuse treatment.

- (1) health facility licensed pursuant to the Public Health Act that provides substance abuse treatment in the regular course of business; or
- (2) person licensed or otherwise authorized pursuant to state law to provide substance abuse treatment in the regular course of business.
