AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; ENACTING THE 2013 WORK NEW
MEXICO ACT; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SEVERANCE TAX BONDS;
AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES FROM CERTAIN FUNDS AND BALANCES;
CLARIFYING CONDITIONS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS; ESTABLISHING
CONDITIONS FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF SEVERANCE TAX BOND PROCEEDS;
ESTABLISHING CONDITIONS FOR THE REVERSION OF UNEXPENDED
BALANCES; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.--This act may be cited as the
"2013 Work New Mexico Act".

SECTION 2. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--AUTHORIZATIONS--
APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS.--

A. The state board of finance may issue and sell
severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax

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1 Bonding Act in an amount not to exceed the total of the amounts
2 authorized for purposes specified in the 2013 Work New Mexico
3 Act. The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance
4 and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical
5 manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project
6 has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and
7 that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable
8 time. The state board of finance shall further take the
9 appropriate steps necessary to comply with the federal Internal
10 Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. Proceeds from the sale of
11 the bonds are appropriated for the purposes specified in the
12 2013 Work New Mexico Act.

13 B. The agencies named in the 2013 Work New Mexico
14 Act shall certify to the state board of finance when the money
15 from the proceeds of the severance tax bonds appropriated in
16 this section is needed for the purposes specified in the
17 applicable section of that act. If an agency has not certified
18 the need for severance tax bond proceeds for a particular
19 project, including projects that have been reauthorized, by the
20 end of fiscal year 2015, the authorization for that project is
21 void.

22 C. Before an agency may certify for the need of
23 severance tax bond proceeds, the project must be developed
24 sufficiently so that the agency reasonably expects to:

- 25 (1) incur within six months after the

1 applicable bond proceeds are available for the project a
2 substantial binding obligation to a third party to expend at
3 least five percent of the bond proceeds for the project; and

4 (2) spend at least eighty-five percent of the
5 bond proceeds within three years after the applicable bond
6 proceeds are available for the project.

7 D. Except as otherwise specifically provided by
8 law:

9 (1) the unexpended balance from the proceeds
10 of severance tax bonds appropriated in this act for a project
11 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund no later than
12 the following dates:

13 (a) for a project for which severance
14 tax bond proceeds were appropriated to match federal grants,
15 six months after completion of the project;

16 (b) for a project for which severance
17 tax bond proceeds were appropriated to purchase vehicles,
18 including emergency vehicles and other vehicles that require
19 special equipment; heavy equipment; books; educational
20 technology; or other equipment or furniture that is not related
21 to a more inclusive construction or renovation project, at the
22 end of the fiscal year two years following the fiscal year in
23 which the severance tax bond proceeds were made available for
24 the purchase; and

25 (c) for any other project for which

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1 severance tax bonds were appropriated, within six months of
2 completion of the project, but no later than the end of fiscal
3 year 2017; and

4 (2) all remaining balances from the proceeds
5 of severance tax bonds appropriated for a project in the 2013
6 Work New Mexico Act shall revert to the severance tax bonding
7 fund three months after the latest reversion date specified for
8 that type of project in Paragraph (1) of this subsection.

9 E. Except for appropriations to the capital program
10 fund, money from severance tax bond proceeds provided pursuant
11 to this act shall not be used to pay indirect project costs.

12 F. Except for a project that was originally funded
13 using a tax-exempt loan or bond issue, a project involving
14 repayment of debt previously incurred shall be funded through
15 the issuance of taxable severance tax bonds with a term that
16 does not extend beyond the fiscal year in which they are
17 issued.

18 G. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
19 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
20 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding
21 written obligations to third parties.

22 SECTION 3. GENERAL FUND AND OTHER FUND APPROPRIATIONS--
23 LIMITATIONS--REVERSIONS.--

24 A. Except as otherwise specifically provided by
25 law:

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1 (1) the unexpended balance of an appropriation
2 made in the 2013 Work New Mexico Act from the general fund or
3 other state funds shall revert no later than the following
4 dates:

5 (a) for a project for which an
6 appropriation was made to match federal grants, six months
7 after completion of the project;

8 (b) for a project for which an
9 appropriation was made to purchase vehicles, including
10 emergency vehicles and other vehicles that require special
11 equipment; heavy equipment; books; educational technology; or
12 other equipment or furniture that is not related to a more
13 inclusive construction or renovation project, at the end of the
14 fiscal year two years following the fiscal year in which the
15 appropriation was made for the purchase; and

16 (c) for any other project for which an
17 appropriation was made, within six months of completion of the
18 project, but no later than the end of fiscal year 2017; and

19 (2) all remaining balances from an
20 appropriation made in the 2013 Work New Mexico Act for a
21 project shall revert three months after the latest reversion
22 date specified for that type of project in Paragraph (1) of
23 this subsection.

24 B. Except for appropriations to the capital program
25 fund, money from appropriations made in the 2013 Work New

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1 Mexico Act shall not be used to pay indirect project costs.

2 C. Except as provided in Subsection E of this
3 section, the balance of an appropriation made from the general
4 fund shall revert in the time frame set forth in Subsection A
5 of this section to the capital projects fund.

6 D. Except as provided in Subsection E of this
7 section, the balance of an appropriation made from other state
8 funds shall revert in the time frame set forth in Subsection A
9 of this section to the originating fund.

10 E. The balance of an appropriation made from the
11 general fund or other state fund to the Indian affairs
12 department or the aging and long-term services department for a
13 project located on lands of an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo
14 shall revert in the time frame set forth in Subsection A of
15 this section to the tribal infrastructure project fund.

16 F. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
17 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
18 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding
19 written obligations to third parties.

20 SECTION 4. ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS PROJECT--
21 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2
22 of the 2013 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification by the
23 administrative office of the courts that the need exists for
24 the issuance of the bonds, one million dollars (\$1,000,000) is
25 appropriated to the administrative office of the courts to

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1 purchase and install security and other equipment and to make
2 infrastructure improvements at magistrate courts and judicial
3 district courts statewide.

4 SECTION 5. AGING AND LONG-TERM SERVICES DEPARTMENT

5 PROJECTS--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of
6 Section 2 of the 2013 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification
7 by the aging and long-term services department that the need
8 exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are
9 appropriated to the aging and long-term services department for
10 the following purposes:

- 11 1. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to
12 purchase and install meals equipment in the Albuquerque
13 centralized kitchen in Bernalillo county;
- 14 2. eleven thousand seven hundred dollars (\$11,700)
15 to purchase and install meals equipment in the Pueblo of Isleta
16 senior center in Bernalillo county;
- 17 3. three thousand eight hundred fifty dollars
18 (\$3,850) to purchase and install meals equipment in the Reserve
19 and Glenwood senior centers in Catron county;
- 20 4. sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) to make
21 improvements for building code compliance, including purchase
22 and installation of equipment, to the Reserve senior center in
23 Catron county;
- 24 5. one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to
25 construct and equip improvements to the senior center at the

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1 Pueblo of Acoma in Cibola county;

2 6. sixteen thousand three hundred dollars (\$16,300)
3 to make improvements for building code compliance, including
4 purchase and installation of equipment, to the Alice Converse
5 senior center in Curry county;

6 7. fifty-five thousand dollars (\$55,000) to make
7 improvements for building code compliance, including purchase
8 and installation of equipment, to the Baxter-Curren senior
9 center in Curry county;

10 8. eleven thousand seven hundred dollars (\$11,700)
11 to purchase and install meals equipment in the Melrose senior
12 center in Curry county;

13 9. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to plan,
14 design, construct, equip and furnish a senior center in Fort
15 Sumner in De Baca county;

16 10. five thousand nine hundred dollars (\$5,900) to
17 purchase and install meals equipment in the Puerto de Luna
18 senior center in Guadalupe county;

19 11. two thousand dollars (\$2,000) to purchase and
20 install meals equipment in the Ena Mitchell senior center in
21 Hidalgo county;

22 12. fifty-five thousand dollars (\$55,000) to make
23 improvements for building code compliance, including purchase
24 and installation of equipment, to the Jal senior center in Lea
25 county;

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1 13. forty-nine thousand four hundred dollars
2 (\$49,400) to purchase and install meals equipment in senior
3 centers countywide in Lincoln county;

4 14. two hundred forty-five thousand dollars
5 (\$245,000) to design, construct, equip and furnish a senior
6 center in Carrizozo in Lincoln county;

7 15. twenty-five thousand one hundred dollars
8 (\$25,100) to purchase and install meals equipment in the
9 Deming-Luna senior center in Luna county;

10 16. one hundred ninety-three thousand five hundred
11 dollars (\$193,500) to plan and design the senior center in the
12 Church Rock chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county;

13 17. seventy-eight thousand five hundred dollars
14 (\$78,500) to make improvements for building code compliance,
15 including purchase and installation of equipment, to the Ford
16 Canyon senior center in Gallup in McKinley county;

17 18. forty-two thousand six hundred dollars
18 (\$42,600) to purchase and install meals equipment in the Gallup
19 citywide senior centers in McKinley county;

20 19. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan,
21 design and construct a senior center in the Manuelito chapter
22 of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county;

23 20. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to
24 construct and renovate the senior center in the Manuelito
25 chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county;

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1 21. one hundred seventy thousand dollars (\$170,000)
2 to plan, design and construct a long-term care facility in the
3 Navajo Nation in Navajo in McKinley county;

4 22. thirty-eight thousand six hundred dollars
5 (\$38,600) to purchase and install meals equipment in the Pueblo
6 of Zuni senior center in McKinley county;

7 23. sixteen thousand three hundred ten dollars
8 (\$16,310) to purchase and install meals equipment in the Mora
9 senior center in Mora county;

10 24. one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars
11 (\$175,000) to plan, design, construct, furnish and equip a
12 senior center in Wagon Mound in Mora county;

13 25. two hundred forty thousand dollars (\$240,000)
14 to furnish and equip the assisted living facilities and senior
15 center in the Pueblo of Isleta in Bernalillo county;

16 26. one hundred three thousand six hundred dollars
17 (\$103,600) to make improvements for building code compliance,
18 including purchase and installation of equipment, to the
19 Alamogordo senior center in Otero county;

20 27. one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars
21 (\$175,000) to plan, design, construct, equip, purchase and
22 install improvements to the senior center and garage, including
23 site improvements and furniture, in Tularosa in Otero county;

24 28. forty-five thousand three hundred dollars
25 (\$45,300) to purchase and install meals equipment in senior

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1 centers countywide in Quay county;

2 29. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to make
3 improvements for building code compliance, including purchase
4 and installation of equipment, to the Tucumcari senior center
5 in Quay county;

6 30. one hundred fifteen thousand nine hundred
7 dollars (\$115,900) to purchase and install meals equipment in
8 senior centers countywide in Rio Arriba county;

9 31. seventy-eight thousand dollars (\$78,000) to
10 make improvements for building code compliance, including
11 purchase and installation of equipment, to the Chama senior
12 center in Rio Arriba county;

13 32. twenty-two thousand four hundred dollars
14 (\$22,400) to purchase and install meals equipment in the
15 Portales senior center community services center in Roosevelt
16 county;

17 33. six thousand seven hundred fifty dollars
18 (\$6,750) to purchase and install meals equipment in the Bonnie
19 Dallas senior center in San Juan county;

20 34. twenty-seven thousand six hundred dollars
21 (\$27,600) to make improvements for building code compliance,
22 including purchase and installation of equipment, to the Bonnie
23 Dallas senior center in San Juan county;

24 35. twelve thousand eight hundred dollars (\$12,800)
25 to make improvements for building code compliance, including

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1 purchase and installation of equipment, to the Lower Valley
2 senior center in San Juan county;

3 36. fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000) to purchase
4 and install meals equipment in the Aztec senior center in San
5 Juan county;

6 37. thirteen thousand two hundred fifty dollars
7 (\$13,250) to purchase and install meals equipment in the Blanco
8 senior center in San Juan county;

9 38. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan and
10 design the renovation and conversion of a senior center to a
11 group home in the Two Grey Hills chapter of the Navajo Nation
12 in San Juan county;

13 39. six thousand three hundred ten dollars (\$6,310)
14 to purchase and install meals equipment in senior centers
15 countywide in San Miguel county;

16 40. forty-four thousand five hundred dollars
17 (\$44,500) to make improvements for building code compliance,
18 including purchase and installation of equipment, to the Jemez
19 senior center in Sandoval county;

20 41. five hundred sixty-two thousand six hundred
21 dollars (\$562,600) to make improvements for building code
22 compliance, including purchase and installation of equipment,
23 lighting and renovations to the parking lot, to the Meadowlark
24 senior center in Sandoval county;

25 42. twenty-nine thousand four hundred fifty dollars

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1 (\$29,450) to purchase and install meals equipment in the
2 Meadowlark senior center in Sandoval county;

3 43. forty-six thousand two hundred dollars

6 44. two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000)
7 to plan, design and construct a senior center in Bernalillo in
8 Sandoval county;

11 senior center in Sandoval county;

12 46. twenty-four thousand one hundred dollars

3 SECTION 6. STATE ARMORY BOARD PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX
4 BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2 of the 2013
5 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification by the state armory
6 board that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, five
7 hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) is appropriated to the
8 state armory board for improvements, repairs and demolition,
9 including energy-efficient systems, to correct infrastructure
10 deficiencies and staging areas at facilities statewide.

11 SECTION 7. BERNALILLO COUNTY METROPOLITAN COURT PROJECT--
12 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2
13 of the 2013 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification by the
14 Bernalillo county metropolitan court that the need exists for
15 the issuance of the bonds, three hundred sixty-nine thousand
16 dollars (\$369,000) is appropriated to the Bernalillo county
17 metropolitan court to plan, design and construct public
18 restroom facilities and egress access on the fourth floor of
19 the Bernalillo county metropolitan courthouse in Albuquerque in
20 Bernalillo county.

21 SECTION 8. BORDER AUTHORITY PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX
22 BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2 of the 2013
23 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification by the border authority
24 that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, three
25 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) is appropriated to

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1 the border authority to construct a commercial lane, including
2 related infrastructure, on the southbound road at the port of
3 entry in Santa Teresa in Dona Ana county.

4 SECTION 9. CAPITAL PROGRAM FUND PROJECTS--SEVERANCE TAX
5 BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2 of the 2013
6 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification by the property control
7 division of the general services department that the need
8 exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are
9 appropriated to the capital program fund for the following
10 purposes:

11 1. three million dollars (\$3,000,000) for building
12 repairs, including ventilation modifications, at the state
13 scientific laboratory building in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
14 county;

15 2. two million eight hundred thousand dollars
16 (\$2,800,000) to remove the existing inoperable digester and to
17 purchase and install a new tissue digester to dispose of
18 carcass and other high-risk infectious disease materials in the
19 veterinary diagnostic services division's facility of the New
20 Mexico department of agriculture in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
21 county;

22 3. two million dollars (\$2,000,000) to plan,
23 design, construct, renovate, equip, furnish and make
24 infrastructure improvements to juvenile detention facilities
25 statewide in support of the Cambiar objectives, including

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1 improvements to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act
2 of 1990 and for accessibility, security and a centralized waste
3 removal system;

4 4. one million five hundred thousand dollars
5 (\$1,500,000) to plan, design, construct and make improvements
6 and other necessary upgrades for liability, energy efficiency,
7 safety and code compliance at the Tiwa building in Albuquerque
8 in Bernalillo county;

9 5. four million three hundred thousand dollars
10 (\$4,300,000) to decommission and demolish, including abatement,
11 the old Fort Bayard medical center in Grant county;

12 6. four million eight hundred thousand dollars
13 (\$4,800,000) for heating, ventilation and air conditioning
14 system upgrades and infrastructure improvements in housing
15 units and support buildings at the central New Mexico
16 correctional facility in Valencia county and the western New
17 Mexico correctional facility in Cibola county;

18 7. two million five hundred thousand dollars
19 (\$2,500,000) for security upgrades, including construction and
20 the purchase and installation of equipment, at correctional
21 facilities statewide;

22 8. four million dollars (\$4,000,000) to plan,
23 design, construct, install and equip patient health and safety
24 upgrades at the New Mexico behavioral health institute in Las
25 Vegas in San Miguel county, at the New Mexico state veterans'

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1 home in Truth or Consequences in Sierra county, at the Sequoyah
2 facility in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county, at the Los Lunas
3 facility in Valencia county and at Fort Bayard medical center
4 in Santa Clara in Grant county;

5 9. one million five hundred thousand dollars
6 (\$1,500,000) for facilities upgrades at the New Mexico
7 behavioral health institute in Las Vegas in San Miguel county,
8 at New Mexico state veterans' home in Truth or Consequences in
9 Sierra county and at the Sequoyah facility in Albuquerque in
10 Bernalillo county;

11 10. three million five hundred thousand dollars
12 (\$3,500,000) to construct, renovate, expand, furnish and equip
13 the state police district office in Espanola in Rio Arriba
14 county;

15 11. eight hundred thousand dollars (\$800,000) for
16 designing, constructing, installing and equipping the state
17 police district office, including a secondary access road, in
18 Las Vegas in San Miguel county;

19 12. two million one hundred thousand dollars
20 (\$2,100,000) to demolish the old Meadows building, including
21 rerouting utilities, excavation and other site improvements, in
22 preparation for phase 3 of the New Meadows building at the New
23 Mexico behavioral health institute in Las Vegas in San Miguel
24 county;

25 13. six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) for

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1 renovations at the dormitories, including upgrading fire
2 suppression and heating, ventilation and air conditioning
3 systems, at the New Mexico law enforcement academy in Santa Fe
4 county;

5 14. six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) for
6 architectural design and to renovate and expand the state
7 commission of public records facility in Santa Fe in Santa Fe
8 county;

9 15. three million five hundred thousand dollars
10 (\$3,500,000) to plan, design, repair and renovate correctional
11 facilities statewide to correct security and safety hazards and
12 address operational interruptions and facility deterioration;

13 16. four million five hundred thousand dollars
14 (\$4,500,000) to plan and design repairs and renovations,
15 infrastructure upgrades and construction, including demolition,
16 at state buildings statewide; and

17 17. one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to plan,
18 design, construct, renovate and furnish the human services
19 department drug and substance abuse treatment facility in Los
20 Lunas in Valencia county.

21 **SECTION 10. CORRECTIONS DEPARTMENT PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX**
22 **BONDS.--**Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2 of the 2013
23 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification by the corrections
24 department that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds,
25 ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) is appropriated to the

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1 corrections department to plan, design, purchase and construct
2 a multipurpose facility serving individuals recently released
3 from prison who are transitioning back into society in the
4 south valley area of Bernalillo county.

25 exists for the issuance of the bonds, one million dollars

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1 (\$1,000,000) is appropriated to the board of regents of New
2 Mexico military institute to design, develop, demolish,
3 purchase, install and equip boilers and chillers throughout the
4 campus of New Mexico military institute in Roswell in Chaves
5 county.

6 SECTION 41. NEW MEXICO INSTITUTE OF MINING AND TECHNOLOGY

8 Section 2 of the 2013 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification
9 by the board of regents of New Mexico institute of mining and

19 purchase and install information technology, including related
20 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at western New Mexico
21 university in Silver City in Grant county; and

22 3. two million five hundred thousand dollars

2 SECTION 46. DEPARTMENT OF GAME AND FISH PROJECT--

3 APPROPRIATION FROM THE GAME AND FISH BOND RETIREMENT FUND.--One
4 million four hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$1,475,000)
5 is appropriated from the game and fish bond retirement fund to
6 the department of game and fish for expenditure in fiscal years
7 2013 through 2017, unless otherwise provided for in Section 3
8 of the 2013 Work New Mexico Act, for designing and constructing

16 appropriated from the game protection fund to the department of
17 game and fish for expenditure in fiscal years 2013 through
18 2017, unless otherwise provided for in Section 3 of the 2013
19 Work New Mexico Act, for facility renovations, including
20 replacing pipeline at Seven Springs hatchery, consolidating
21 warehouses and headquarters properties, designing and
22 constructing Bear Canyon dam, constructing Rock Lake hatchery,
23 constructing and renovating Lake Roberts dam and spillway,
24 purchasing the northwest area office in Albuquerque and
25 alternative energy assessments, statewide.

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1 **SECTION 48. DEPARTMENT OF GAME AND FISH PROJECT--**

2 APPROPRIATION FROM THE HABITAT MANAGEMENT FUND.--Two million
 3 one hundred thousand dollars (\$2,100,000) is appropriated from
 4 the habitat management fund to the department of game and fish
 5 for expenditure in fiscal years 2013 through 2017, unless
 6 otherwise provided for in Section 3 of the 2013 Work New Mexico
 7 Act, for design and construction of Bear Canyon dam, to replace
 8 pipeline at Seven Springs hatchery, to construct and renovate
 9 Lake Roberts dam and spillway and to improve wildlife
 10 management areas statewide.

11 **SECTION 49. MINERS' COLFAX MEDICAL CENTER PROJECT--**

12 APPROPRIATION FROM THE MINERS' TRUST FUND.--Three million two
 13 hundred thousand dollars (\$3,200,000) is appropriated from the
 14 miners' trust fund to the miners' Colfax medical center for
 15 expenditure in fiscal years 2013 through 2017, unless otherwise
 16 provided for in Section 3 of the 2013 Work New Mexico Act, to
 17 plan, design, construct, equip and furnish an outpatient clinic
 18 to serve residents of Colfax county.

19 **SECTION 50. OFFICE OF THE STATE ENGINEER PROJECT--**

20 APPROPRIATION FROM THE PUBLIC PROJECT REVOLVING FUND.--One
 21 million dollars (\$1,000,000) is appropriated from the public
 22 project revolving fund to the office of the state engineer for
 23 expenditure in fiscal years 2013 through 2017, unless otherwise
 24 provided for in Section 3 of the 2013 Work New Mexico Act, to
 25 purchase and install surface and ground water meters to assess

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1 water use, water supply, impairment, public welfare,
2 conservation and water accountability statewide.

3 SECTION 51. WASTEWATER FACILITY CONSTRUCTION LOAN FUND--
4 APPROPRIATION FROM THE PUBLIC PROJECT REVOLVING FUND.--One
5 million four hundred thousand dollars (\$1,400,000) is
6 appropriated from the public project revolving fund to the
7 wastewater facility construction loan fund to implement the
8 provisions of the Wastewater Facility Construction Loan Act or
9 to provide state matching funds required by the terms of any
10 federal grant under the Clean Water Act.

11 SECTION 52. NEW MEXICO SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF PROJECTS--
12 APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL OUTLAY FUND.--The
13 following amounts are appropriated from the public school
14 capital outlay fund, contingent upon approval of the public
15 school capital outlay council, to the board of regents of the
16 New Mexico school for the deaf for expenditure in fiscal years
17 2013 through 2017, unless otherwise provided for in Section 3
18 of the 2013 Work New Mexico Act, for the following purposes:

19 1. seven million dollars (\$7,000,000) to purchase,
20 install, plan, design, renovate and construct improvements to
21 infrastructure throughout the campus of the New Mexico school
22 for the deaf in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county; and

23 2. one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to plan, design
24 and construct the consolidation of the museum and library and
25 remodel Dillon hall to accommodate outreach and early

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1 intervention programs at the New Mexico school for the deaf in
2 Santa Fe in Santa Fe county.

3 SECTION 53. PUBLIC EDUCATION DEPARTMENT PROJECTS--
4 APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL OUTLAY FUND.--The
5 following amounts are appropriated from the public school
6 capital outlay fund, contingent upon approval of the public
7 school capital outlay council, to the public education
8 department for expenditure in fiscal years 2013 through 2017,
9 unless otherwise provided for in Section 3 of the 2013 Work New
10 Mexico Act, for the following purposes:

11 1. two million five hundred thousand dollars
12 (\$2,500,000) to renovate and construct public school pre-
13 kindergarten classrooms statewide; and

14 2. thirteen million dollars (\$13,000,000) to
15 purchase school buses statewide.

16 SECTION 54. NEW MEXICO SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND AND VISUALLY
17 IMPAIRED PROJECTS--APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE PUBLIC SCHOOL
18 CAPITAL OUTLAY FUND.--The following amounts are appropriated
19 from the public school capital outlay fund, contingent upon
20 approval of the public school capital outlay council, to the
21 board of regents of the New Mexico school for the blind and
22 visually impaired for expenditure in fiscal years 2013 through
23 2017, unless otherwise provided for in Section 3 of the 2013
24 Work New Mexico Act, for the following purposes:

25 1. eight hundred thirty-eight thousand dollars

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1 (\$838,000) for renovations to Jack hall and the health services
2 buildings and to relocate health services to Jack hall and to
3 relocate the library to the current health services building at
4 the New Mexico school for the blind and visually impaired in
5 Alamogordo in Otero county;

6 2. two million nine hundred thousand dollars
7 (\$2,900,000) to plan, design and construct phase 1 improvements
8 to the site, utilities and critical infrastructure at the New
9 Mexico school for the blind and visually impaired in Alamogordo
10 in Otero county; and

11 3. five million five hundred thousand dollars
12 (\$5,500,000) to plan, design, renovate and equip the Watkins
13 education center and to demolish the San Andres building at the
14 New Mexico school for the blind and visually impaired in
15 Alamogordo in Otero county.

16 SECTION 55. STATE LAND OFFICE PROJECTS--APPROPRIATIONS
17 FROM THE STATE LANDS MAINTENANCE FUND.--The following amounts
18 are appropriated from the state lands maintenance fund to the
19 state land office for expenditure in fiscal years 2013 through
20 2017, unless otherwise provided for in Section 3 of the 2013
21 Work New Mexico Act, for the following purposes:

22 1. three hundred seventy-five thousand dollars
23 (\$375,000) for electrical upgrades, including the purchase and
24 installation of electric panels, at the state land office in
25 Santa Fe in Santa Fe county;

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1 2. one hundred five thousand dollars (\$105,000) for
2 planning, designing and demolishing and for security
3 construction upgrades at the front entryway, including
4 replacement of exterior entry flooring and a front entry
5 enclosure with security doors and cameras, at the state land
6 office in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county; and

7 3. ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) to plan and
8 design the renovation of Morgan hall at the state land office
9 in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county.

10 **SECTION 56. PROJECT SCOPE--EXPENDITURES.**--If an
11 appropriation for a project authorized in the 2013 Work New
12 Mexico Act is not sufficient to complete all the purposes
13 specified, the appropriation may be expended for any portion of
14 the purposes specified in the appropriation. Expenditures
15 shall not be made for purposes other than those specified in
16 the appropriation.

17 **SECTION 57. ART IN PUBLIC PLACES.**--Pursuant to Section
18 13-4A-4 NMSA 1978 and where applicable, the appropriations
19 authorized in the 2013 Work New Mexico Act include one percent
20 for the art in public places fund.

21 **SECTION 58. EMERGENCY.**--It is necessary for the public
22 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
