D. The commission shall meet at the call of the chair as necessary to carry out its duties, but no less than twice a month. The first meeting shall be held no later than May 1, 2013.

E. Three absences from meetings of the commission shall constitute grounds for removal of a public member of the commission. Upon the request of the chair of the commission, the appointing authority shall replace the public member who has failed to attend three meetings of the commission.

F. A majority of the members appointed constitutes a quorum for the transaction of business. The support of a majority of the members appointed is required for adoption of any action by the commission; provided, however, that the final report of the commission, including its recommendations and proposed legislation, must have the support of a majority of the legislative members.

G. The commission shall develop recommendations for reform of New Mexico's tax laws to establish a balanced tax system that provides maximum economic development benefits, maintains necessary government services at an appropriate level and recognizes the need for tribal governments to raise tax revenues from economic activity within the tribal boundaries. The commission shall examine New Mexico's tax system, identify its strengths and deficiencies and consider a broad range of

improvements that could be made to modernize the tax system and make it more conducive to economic growth, including economic growth on lands subject to the jurisdiction of an Indian tribe, nation or pueblo located wholly or partly within New Mexico. The commission shall examine all tax expenditures approved and determine if any changes are necessary and the structure of any such changes. The commission shall submit a report of its findings, including specific recommendations and proposed legislation, to the governor and the New Mexico legislative council no later than November 1, 2013.

H. The commission shall hire or contract for appropriate staff. Staff shall assist the commission as directed by the chair, including conducting interviews with parties that wish to express their views to the commission and synthesizing this information for the commission. The commission may request assistance from the legislative council service, legislative finance committee and the taxation and revenue department.

I. Members of the commission shall be entitled to receive per diem and mileage expenses as provided for public officers in the Per Diem and Mileage Act.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.--Two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the legislative council service for expenditure in fiscal years 2013 and 2014 to carry out the provisions of this act,
