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AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; ENACTING THE 2013 WORK  
NEW MEXICO ACT; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SEVERANCE TAX  
BONDS; AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES FROM CERTAIN FUNDS AND  
BALANCES; CLARIFYING CONDITIONS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS;  
ESTABLISHING CONDITIONS FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF SEVERANCE TAX  
BOND PROCEEDS; ESTABLISHING CONDITIONS FOR THE REVERSION OF  
UNEXPENDED BALANCES; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS; DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.--This act may be cited as the  
"2013 Work New Mexico Act".

SECTION 2. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--AUTHORIZATIONS--  
APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS.--

A. The state board of finance may issue and sell  
severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax  
Bonding Act in an amount not to exceed the total of the  
amounts authorized for purposes specified in the 2013 Work  
New Mexico Act. The state board of finance shall schedule  
the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious  
and economical manner possible upon a finding by the board  
that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify  
the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract  
within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall

1 further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with  
2 the federal Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

3 Proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated for the  
4 purposes specified in the 2013 Work New Mexico Act.

5 B. The agencies named in the 2013 Work New Mexico  
6 Act shall certify to the state board of finance when the  
7 money from the proceeds of the severance tax bonds  
8 appropriated in this section is needed for the purposes  
9 specified in the applicable section of that act. If an  
10 agency has not certified the need for severance tax bond  
11 proceeds for a particular project, including projects that  
12 have been reauthorized, by the end of fiscal year 2015, the  
13 authorization for that project is void.

14 C. Before an agency may certify for the need of  
15 severance tax bond proceeds, the project must be developed  
16 sufficiently so that the agency reasonably expects to:

17 (1) incur within six months after the  
18 applicable bond proceeds are available for the project a  
19 substantial binding obligation to a third party to expend at  
20 least five percent of the bond proceeds for the project; and

21 (2) spend at least eighty-five percent of  
22 the bond proceeds within three years after the applicable  
23 bond proceeds are available for the project.

24 D. Except as otherwise specifically provided by  
25 law:

1                   (1) the unexpended balance from the proceeds  
2 of severance tax bonds appropriated in this act for a project  
3 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund no later than  
4 the following dates:

5                   (a) for a project for which severance  
6 tax bond proceeds were appropriated to match federal grants,  
7 six months after completion of the project;

8                   (b) for a project for which severance  
9 tax bond proceeds were appropriated to purchase vehicles,  
10 including emergency vehicles and other vehicles that require  
11 special equipment; heavy equipment; books; educational  
12 technology; or other equipment or furniture that is not  
13 related to a more inclusive construction or renovation  
14 project, at the end of the fiscal year two years following  
15 the fiscal year in which the severance tax bond proceeds were  
16 made available for the purchase; and

17                   (c) for any other project for which  
18 severance tax bonds were appropriated, within six months of  
19 completion of the project, but no later than the end of  
20 fiscal year 2017; and

21                   (2) all remaining balances from the proceeds  
22 of severance tax bonds appropriated for a project in the 2013  
23 Work New Mexico Act shall revert to the severance tax bonding  
24 fund three months after the latest reversion date specified  
25 for that type of project in Paragraph (1) of this subsection.

1           E. Except for appropriations to the capital  
2 program fund, money from severance tax bond proceeds provided  
3 pursuant to this act shall not be used to pay indirect  
4 project costs.

5           F. Except for a project that was originally funded  
6 using a tax-exempt loan or bond issue, a project involving  
7 repayment of debt previously incurred shall be funded through  
8 the issuance of taxable severance tax bonds with a term that  
9 does not extend beyond the fiscal year in which they are  
10 issued.

11           G. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended  
12 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after  
13 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding  
14 written obligations to third parties.

15           SECTION 3. GENERAL FUND AND OTHER FUND APPROPRIATIONS--  
16 LIMITATIONS--REVERSIONS.--

17           A. Except as otherwise specifically provided by  
18 law:

19                   (1) the unexpended balance of an  
20 appropriation made in the 2013 Work New Mexico Act from the  
21 general fund or other state funds shall revert no later than  
22 the following dates:

23                           (a) for a project for which an  
24 appropriation was made to match federal grants, six months  
25 after completion of the project;

1 (b) for a project for which an  
2 appropriation was made to purchase vehicles, including  
3 emergency vehicles and other vehicles that require special  
4 equipment; heavy equipment; books; educational technology; or  
5 other equipment or furniture that is not related to a more  
6 inclusive construction or renovation project, at the end of  
7 the fiscal year two years following the fiscal year in which  
8 the appropriation was made for the purchase; and

9 (c) for any other project for which an  
10 appropriation was made, within six months of completion of  
11 the project, but no later than the end of fiscal year 2017;  
12 and

13 (2) all remaining balances from an  
14 appropriation made in the 2013 Work New Mexico Act for a  
15 project shall revert three months after the latest reversion  
16 date specified for that type of project in Paragraph (1) of  
17 this subsection.

18 B. Except for appropriations to the capital  
19 program fund, money from appropriations made in the 2013 Work  
20 New Mexico Act shall not be used to pay indirect project  
21 costs.

22 C. Except as provided in Subsection E of this  
23 section, the balance of an appropriation made from the  
24 general fund shall revert in the time frame set forth in  
25 Subsection A of this section to the capital projects fund.

1           D. Except as provided in Subsection E of this  
2 section, the balance of an appropriation made from other  
3 state funds shall revert in the time frame set forth in  
4 Subsection A of this section to the originating fund.

5           E. The balance of an appropriation made from the  
6 general fund or other state fund to the Indian affairs  
7 department or the aging and long-term services department for  
8 a project located on lands of an Indian nation, tribe or  
9 pueblo shall revert in the time frame set forth in Subsection  
10 A of this section to the tribal infrastructure project fund.

11           F. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended  
12 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after  
13 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding  
14 written obligations to third parties.

15           SECTION 4. ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS

16 PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of  
17 Section 2 of the 2013 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification  
18 by the administrative office of the courts that the need  
19 exists for the issuance of the bonds, one million dollars  
20 (\$1,000,000) is appropriated to the administrative office of  
21 the courts to purchase and install security and other  
22 equipment and to make infrastructure improvements at  
23 magistrate courts and judicial district courts statewide.

24           SECTION 5. AGING AND LONG-TERM SERVICES DEPARTMENT

25 PROJECTS--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of

1 Section 2 of the 2013 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification  
2 by the aging and long-term services department that the need  
3 exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts  
4 are appropriated to the aging and long-term services  
5 department for the following purposes:

6 1. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to  
7 purchase and install meals equipment in the Albuquerque  
8 centralized kitchen in Bernalillo county;

9 2. eleven thousand seven hundred dollars (\$11,700)  
10 to purchase and install meals equipment in the Pueblo of  
11 Isleta senior center in Bernalillo county;

12 3. three thousand eight hundred fifty dollars  
13 (\$3,850) to purchase and install meals equipment in the  
14 Reserve and Glenwood senior centers in Catron county;

15 4. sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) to make

25 SECTION 6. STATE ARMORY BOARD PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX

1 BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2 of the 2013  
2 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification by the state armory  
3 board that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds,  
4 five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) is appropriated to  
5 the state armory board for improvements, repairs and  
6 demolition, including energy-efficient systems, to correct  
7 infrastructure deficiencies and staging areas at facilities  
8 statewide.

9 SECTION 7. BERNALILLO COUNTY METROPOLITAN COURT

10 PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of  
11 Section 2 of the 2013 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification  
12 by the Bernalillo county metropolitan court that the need  
13 exists for the issuance of the bonds, three hundred  
14 sixty-nine thousand dollars (\$369,000) is appropriated to the  
15 Bernalillo county metropolitan court to plan, design and  
16 construct public restroom facilities and egress access on the  
17 fourth floor of the Bernalillo county metropolitan courthouse  
18 in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county.

19 SECTION 8. BORDER AUTHORITY PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX

20 BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2 of the 2013  
21 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification by the border  
22 authority that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds,  
23 three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) is  
24 appropriated to the border authority to construct a  
25 commercial lane, including related infrastructure, on the



1 southbound road at the port of entry in Santa Teresa in  
2 Dona Ana county.

3 SECTION 9. CAPITAL PROGRAM FUND PROJECTS--SEVERANCE TAX  
4 BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2 of the 2013  
5 Work New Mexico Act, upon certification by the property  
6 control division of the general services department that the  
7 need exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following  
8 amounts are appropriated to the capital program fund for the  
9 following purposes:

10 1. three million dollars (\$3,000,000) for building  
11 repairs, including ventilation modifications, at the state  
12 scientific laboratory building in Albuquerque in Bernalillo  
13 county;

14 2. two million eight hundred thousand dollars  
15 (\$2,800,000) to remove the existing inoperable digester and  
16 to purchase and install a new tissue digester to dispose of  
17 carcass and other high-risk infectious disease materials in  
18 the veterinary diagnostic services division's facility of the  
19 New Mexico department of agriculture in Albuquerque in  
20 Bernalillo county;

21 3. two million dollars (\$2,000,000) to plan,  
22 design, construct, renovate, equip, furnish and make  
23 infrastructure improvements to juvenile detention facilities  
24 statewide in support of the Cambiar objectives, including  
25 improvements to comply with the Americans with Disabilities

1 Act of 1990 and for accessibility, security and a centralized  
2 waste removal system;

3 4. one million five hundred thousand dollars  
4 (\$1,500,000) to plan, design, construct and make improvements  
5 and other necessary upgrades for liability, energy  
6 efficiency, safety and code compliance at the Tiwa building  
7 in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

8 5. four million three hundred thousand dollars  
9 (\$4,300,000) to decommission and demolish, including  
10 abatement, the old Fort Bayard medical center in Grant  
11 county;

12 6. four million eight hundred thousand dollars  
13 (\$4,800,000) for heating, ventilation and air conditioning  
14 system upgrades and infrastructure improvements in housing  
15 units and support buildings at the central New Mexico  
16 correctional facility in Valencia county and the western  
17 New Mexico correctional facility in Cibola county;

18 7. two million five hundred thousand dollars  
19 (\$2,500,000) for security upgrades, including construction  
20 and the purchase and installation of equipment, at  
21 correctional facilities statewide;

22 8. four million dollars (\$4,000,000) to plan,  
23 design, construct, install and equip patient health and  
24 safety upgrades at the New Mexico behavioral health institute  
25 in Las Vegas in San Miguel county, at the New Mexico state

1 veterans' home in Truth or Consequences in Sierra county, at  
2 the Sequoyah facility in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county, at  
3 the Los Lunas facility in Valencia county and at Fort Bayard  
4 medical center in Santa Clara in Grant county;

5 9. one million five hundred thousand dollars  
6 (\$1,500,000) for facilities upgrades at the New Mexico  
7 behavioral health institute in Las Vegas in San Miguel  
8 county, at New Mexico state veterans' home in Truth or  
9 Consequences in Sierra county and at the Sequoyah facility in  
10 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

11 10. three million five hundred thousand dollars  
12 (\$3,500,000) to construct, renovate, expand, furnish and  
13 equip the state police district office in Espanola in  
14 Rio Arriba county;

15 11. eight hundred thousand dollars (\$800,000) for  
16 designing, constructing, installing and equipping the state  
17 police district office, including a secondary access road, in  
18 Las Vegas in San Miguel county;

19 12. two million one hundred thousand dollars  
20 (\$2,100,000) to demolish the old Meadows building, including  
21 rerouting utilities, excavation and other site improvements,  
22 in preparation for phase 3 of the New Meadows building at the  
23 New Mexico behavioral health institute in Las Vegas in  
24 San Miguel county;

25 13. six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) for

1 renovations at the dormitories, including upgrading fire  
2 suppression and heating, ventilation and air conditioning  
3 systems, at the New Mexico law enforcement academy in  
4 Santa Fe county;

5 14. six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) for  
6 architectural design and to renovate and expand the state  
7 commission of public records facility in Santa Fe in Santa Fe  
8 county;

9 15. three million five hundred thousand dollars  
10 (\$3,500,000) to plan, design, repair and renovate  
11 correctional facilities statewide to correct security and  
12 safety hazards and address operational interruptions and  
13 facility deterioration;

14 16. four million five hundred thousand dollars  
15 (\$4,500,000) to plan and design repairs and renovations,  
16 infrastructure upgrades and construction, including  
17 demolition, at state buildings statewide; and

18 17. one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to plan,  
19 design, construct, renovate and furnish the human services  
20 department drug and substance abuse treatment facility in

5 SECTION 52. NEW MEXICO SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF PROJECTS--  
6 APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL OUTLAY FUND.--

7 The following amounts are appropriated from the public school  
8 capital outlay fund, contingent upon approval of the public  
9 school capital outlay council, to the board of regents of the  
10 New Mexico school for the deaf for expenditure in fiscal  
11 years 2013 through 2017, unless otherwise provided for in  
12 Section 3 of the 2013 Work New Mexico Act, for the following  
13 purposes:

14 1. seven million dollars (\$7,000,000) to purchase,  
15 install, plan, design, renovate and construct improvements to  
16 infrastructure throughout the campus of the New Mexico school  
17 for the deaf in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county; and

18 2. one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to plan,  
19 design and construct the consolidation of the museum and  
20 library and remodel Dillon hall to accommodate outreach and  
21 early intervention programs at the New Mexico school for the  
22 deaf in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county.

23 SECTION 53. PUBLIC EDUCATION DEPARTMENT PROJECTS--  
24 APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL OUTLAY FUND.--

25 The following amounts are appropriated from the public school

1 capital outlay fund, contingent upon approval of the public  
2 school capital outlay council, to the public education  
3 department for expenditure in fiscal years 2013 through 2017,  
4 unless otherwise provided for in Section 3 of the 2013 Work  
5 New Mexico Act, for the following purposes:

6 1. two million five hundred thousand dollars  
7 (\$2,500,000) to renovate and construct public school  
8 pre-kindergarten classrooms statewide; and

9 2. thirteen million dollars (\$13,000,000) to  
10 purchase school buses statewide.

11 SECTION 54. NEW MEXICO SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND AND  
12 VISUALLY IMPAIRED PROJECTS--APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE PUBLIC  
13 SCHOOL CAPITAL OUTLAY FUND.--The following amounts are  
14 appropriated from the public school capital outlay fund,  
15 contingent upon approval of the public school capital outlay  
16 council, to the board of regents of the New Mexico school for  
17 the blind and visually impaired for expenditure in fiscal  
18 years 2013 through 2017, unless otherwise provided for in  
19 Section 3 of the 2013 Work New Mexico Act, for the following  
20 purposes:

21 1. eight hundred thirty-eight thousand dollars  
22 (\$838,000) for renovations to Jack hall and the health  
23 services buildings and to relocate health services to Jack  
24 hall and to relocate the library to the current health  
25 services building at the New Mexico school for the blind and

1 visually impaired in Alamogordo in Otero county;

2           2. two million nine hundred thousand dollars  
3 (\$2,900,000) to plan, design and construct phase 1  
4 improvements to the site, utilities and critical  
5 infrastructure at the New Mexico school for the blind and  
6 visually impaired in Alamogordo in Otero county; and

7           3. five million five hundred thousand dollars  
8 (\$5,500,000) to plan, design, renovate and equip the Watkins  
9 education center and to demolish the San Andres building at  
10 the New Mexico school for the blind and visually impaired in  
11 Alamogordo in Otero county.

12           SECTION 55. STATE LAND OFFICE PROJECTS--APPROPRIATIONS  
13 FROM THE STATE LANDS MAINTENANCE FUND.--The following amounts  
14 are appropriated from the state lands maintenance fund to the  
15 state land office for expenditure in fiscal years 2013  
16 through 2017, unless otherwise provided for in Section 3 of  
17 the 2013 Work New Mexico Act, for the following purposes:

18           1. three hundred seventy-five thousand dollars  
19 (\$375,000) for electrical upgrades, including the purchase  
20 and installation of electric panels, at the state land office  
21 in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county;

22           2. one hundred five thousand dollars (\$105,000)  
23 for planning, designing and demolishing and for security  
24 construction upgrades at the front entryway, including  
25 replacement of exterior entry flooring and a front entry

1 enclosure with security doors and cameras, at the state land  
2 office in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county; and

3 3. ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) to plan and  
4 design the renovation of Morgan hall at the state land office  
5 in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county.

6 SECTION 56. PROJECT SCOPE--EXPENDITURES.--If an  
7 appropriation for a project authorized in the 2013 Work  
8 New Mexico Act is not sufficient to complete all the purposes  
9 specified, the appropriation may be expended for any portion  
10 of the purposes specified in the appropriation. Expenditures  
11 shall not be made for purposes other than those specified in  
12 the appropriation.

13 SECTION 57. ART IN PUBLIC PLACES.--Pursuant to Section  
14 13-4A-4 NMSA 1978 and where applicable, the appropriations  
15 authorized in the 2013 Work New Mexico Act include one  
16 percent for the art in public places fund.

17 SECTION 58. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public  
18 peace, health and safety that this act take effect
