Synopsis of Bill

This bill adds a new subsection to Section 77-1-12 (local control by ordinance; dogs and cats running at large) to state that municipalities and counties shall not adopt an ordinance or rule that regulates dogs in a breed-specific way.

The effective date is July 1, 2013.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES
