### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 339 (HB 339) proposes to amend the School Personnel Act (Section 22-10A-19.2 NMSA 1978) by changing the adoption date for the annual Educator Accountability Report from November to July 1<sup>st</sup>, to be effective starting January 2014. In addition, HB 339 removes the word “statewide” in the statute where that word appears before phrases including “educator accountability.”

The PED will be responsible for communicating to post-secondary institutions, the adoption date for the annual Educator Accountability Report from November to July 1<sup>st</sup>, to be effective starting January 2014.
