#### Synopsis of Bill

House Joint Memorial 16 requests the New Mexico Department of Agriculture study the feasibility of humane horse slaughter and establishing processing facilities in New Mexico and report to the appropriate interim committee of the Legislature by December 1, 2013.

#### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The study will need to be funded from the operating budget of the Department of Agriculture.

#### SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The joint memorial states horse slaughter is a controversial and emotional issue but thousands of unwanted horses are exposed to abandonment and neglect and are shipped to other countries for slaughter. Human horse processing facilities reduce suffering and will meet overseas export markets for horse meat in a humane manner.
