House Memorial 62 recognizes Max Coll for his outstanding service to the state of New Mexico.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Max Coll is a former New Mexico state representative elected to represent the Roswell delegation 1969, and again elected to represent the Santa Fe district in 1981. Among his other accomplishments in the legislature, he was a prime sponsor of the New Mexico equal rights amendment and passed legislation to require funding for arts education. During his leave as a Legislator, Representative Coll served as Chair of the House Taxation and Revenue Committee and then for 17 years Chair of the Appropriation and Finance Committee.
