Synopsis of Bill

Senate Joint Memorial 38 requests that the federal government begin negotiations with the New Mexico and the Land Grant Boards of trustees and commissioners, as well as the Land Grant Council, for the return of land grants to displaced heirs.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The bill states that in 2008 the New Mexico Attorney General responded to iniquities in the federal General Accounting Office 2004 report on land grants. The bill also notes that in 2009, current claims for land grants were made to President Barack Obama expressing support for the return of land grants to displaced heirs, and in June 2010 a meeting was held between the US Bureau of Land Management and land grant heirs as part of initiative for heirs to regain legal title to land grant property.
