The memorial adds that ear ly interv ention in tho form of r e me di al instructien, qositive rein f o reement dna eounseling nac help dy sl ex ic chilbron manage thoir bisadility and decome more probuctive ad ul ts;

The memorial notes that dyslexia is a reading disability that affects nearly ten percent of the population and is the most common learning disability; the symptoms of dyslexia include difficulty understanding simple written sentences, difficulty rhyming and difficulty recognizing written words. The memorial adds that early intervention in the form of remedial instruction, positive reinforcement and counseling can help dyslexic children manage their disability and become productive adults.
