### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Memorial

Senate Memorial requests a task force be convened to study the creation of a higher education scholarship for American Indian students.

### SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The memorial resolves the task force be co-chaired by the Secretary of the Indian Affairs Department and the director of American Indian student services at the University of New Mexico with task force members from the Legislative Education Study Committee, Institute of American Indian Arts, Navajo Technical College, Dine College, Southwester Indian Polytechnic Institute, Central New Mexico Community College, Northern New Mexico College, the Eight Northern Indian Pueblos Council (three representatives), the Ten Southern Pueblos Council (three representatives), Navajo Nation, and the Higher Education Department.

### TECHNICAL ISSUES

The memorial has no reporting requirements for findings of the task force.
