A JOINT MEMORIAL

URGING GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES THROUGHOUT THE STATE TO PURCHASE MATERIALS, GOODS AND SERVICES FROM NEW MEXICAN AND AMERICAN CORPORATIONS TO THE GREATEST EXTENT POSSIBLE.

WHEREAS, the recent economic recession has had a significant negative impact on families and businesses throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS, many foreign governments subsidize or control the manufacture and production of a number of goods and products that are distributed and sold in the United States, which gives those foreign governments and corporations a competitive advantage over American corporations that manufacture and produce goods and products in the United States; and

WHEREAS, in many foreign countries that subsidize and control the manufacture and production of goods and services

1 within their borders, the workers are not paid a living wage,
2 provided with adequate benefits or protected by regulations
3 that require safe and healthy working conditions; and

4 WHEREAS, American workers and the corporations that employ
5 them are at an economic disadvantage because it is
6 significantly less expensive to produce and manufacture goods
7 and services in countries that lack meaningful regulatory
8 controls and work force protections; and

9 WHEREAS, at the expense of American workers, many American
10 corporations have outsourced jobs and executive operations,
11 along with the production and manufacture of goods and
12 services, to foreign countries to take advantage of the lower
13 employment and operating costs that are available in those
14 countries; and

15 WHEREAS, American governmental entities spend trillions of
16 dollars per year procuring goods and services from nondomestic
17 sources that produce and manufacture goods and services outside
18 of the United States; and

19 WHEREAS, American taxpayers provide the revenue that
20 governmental entities throughout the United States use to
21 purchase goods and services that are produced and manufactured
22 in foreign countries; and

23 WHEREAS, if American governmental entities purchased more
24 goods and services from American corporations that produce and
25 manufacture those products using American workers in the United

1 States, there would be a significant economic boost to the
2 American economy, which would greatly benefit American workers
3 and corporations;

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
5 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that governmental entities throughout the
6 state of New Mexico be urged, to the greatest extent possible,
7 to buy materials, goods and services from corporations that
8 produce, manufacture and supply those products and services
9 within the state of New Mexico or the United States to help
10 encourage the creation of jobs for American workers and to
11 improve economic conditions within the United States on local,
12 state and national levels; and

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that governmental entities
14 throughout the state be urged to evaluate state and local
15 procurement procedures to identify barriers to purchasing goods
16 and services that have been produced and manufactured in New
17 Mexico and the United States by American workers; and

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
19 transmitted to the New Mexico association of counties, the New
20 Mexico municipal league and the director of the local
21 government division of the department of finance and
22 administration.
