Honorable Speaker Martinez and Members of the House:

Pursuant to the Constitution of the State of New Mexico, Article IV, Section 22, I hereby VETO and return HOUSE BILL 155, as amended, enacted by the Fifty-First Legislature, First Session, 2013.

House Bill 155 imposes a \$5 fee associated with newly issued, renewal, or replacement disabled parking placards—a service currently provided free of charge. During these challenging economic times, I cannot sign legislation that would impose a fee on New Mexico's elderly and other individuals with disabilities that may live on a fixed income.
