18	for expenditure in fiscal year 2015 for the autism programs at
19	the university of New Mexico to develop and provide clinical
20	services, which are founded on evidence-based treatment
21	practices, for children with autism spectrum disorders and
22	significant problem behaviors. Any unexpended or unencumbered
23	balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2015 shall revert
24	to the general fund.
25	B. One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) is
