AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS; ADDING MEMBERS TO THE INTEROPERABILITY PLANNING COMMISSION THAT IS ADMINISTRATIVELY ATTACHED TO THE HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 12-10D-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2009, Chapter 111, Section 3) is amended to read:

"12-10D-3. INTEROPERABILITY PLANNING COMMISSION--
CREATED.--

A. The "interoperability planning commission" is created and administratively attached to the department.

B. The interoperability planning commission is a permanent advisory commission created to advise and support the department on emergency response and homeland security

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1 activities relating to interoperability, the obtaining of
2 funding and the use of available funding.

3 C. The commission consists of [~~twelve~~] fifteen
4 members, including:

- 5 (1) the lieutenant governor;
- 6 (2) the homeland security advisor;
- 7 (3) the secretary of information technology or
8 the secretary's designee;
- 9 (4) the adjutant general or a representative
10 from the department of military affairs;
- 11 (5) the secretary of energy, minerals and
12 natural resources or the secretary's designee;
- 13 (6) the state fire marshal or the fire
14 marshal's designee;
- 15 (7) the secretary of Indian affairs or the
16 secretary's designee;
- 17 (8) the secretary of transportation or the
18 secretary's designee;
- 19 (9) the secretary of health or the secretary's
20 designee;
- 21 (10) the secretary of public safety or the
22 secretary's designee;
- 23 (11) the executive director of the New Mexico
24 municipal league or the executive director's designee; [~~and~~]
- 25 (12) the executive director of the New Mexico

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1 association of counties or the executive director's designee;
2 (13) the president of the Albuquerque local
3 chapter of the international association of firefighters or the
4 president's designee;

5 (14) the president of the Albuquerque police
6 officers association or the president's designee; and

7 (15) the president of the New Mexico state
8 police association or the president's designee.

9 D. The commission shall appoint a chair and vice
10 chair from among its members. The commission shall meet at the
11 call of the chair but no less than two times each year.

12 E. Members of the commission, or their designees,
13 who are not supported by public money in their role as a member
14 may be reimbursed for per diem and mileage pursuant to the Per
15 Diem and Mileage Act, but shall not receive any other
16 compensation, perquisite or allowance."
