11 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE TRIBAL COLLEGE DUAL CREDIT
12 PROGRAM FUND.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--One million five hundred
16 thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) is appropriated from the general
17 fund to the tribal college dual credit program fund for
18 expenditure in fiscal year 2015 and subsequent fiscal years to
19 compensate tribal colleges as provided in Section 21-1-1.2 NMSA
20 1978 for foregone revenue due to the waiver of tuition and fees
21 by the tribal colleges for high school students participating
22 in the tribal college dual credit program during the preceding
23 school year. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
24 at the end of a fiscal year shall not revert to the general
25 fund.
