18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
19	SECTION 1. Section 50-4-22 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1955,
20	Chapter 200, Section 3, as amended) is amended to read:
21	"50-4-22. MINIMUM WAGES
22	A. Except as provided in Subsections E and F of
23	this section, an employer shall pay an employee the minimum
24	wage rate of six dollars fifty cents (\$6.50) an hour. As of
25	January 1, 2009, an employer shall pay the minimum wage rate of

1 seven dollars fifty cents (\$7.50) an hour.

An employer furnishing food, utilities, supplies Β. or housing to an employee who is engaged in agriculture may deduct the reasonable value of such furnished items from any wages due to the employee.

An employee who customarily and regularly C. 7 receives more than thirty dollars (\$30.00) a month in tips 8 shall be paid a minimum hourly wage of two dollars thirteen 9 cents (\$2.13). The employer may consider tips as part of wages, but the tips combined with the employer's cash wage 10 shall not equal less than the minimum wage rate as provided in 11 12 Subsection A of this section. All tips received by such employees shall be retained by the employee, except that nothing in this section shall prohibit the pooling of tips among employees. 15

An employee shall not be required to work more D. than forty hours in any week of seven days, unless the employee is paid one and one-half times the employee's regular hourly rate of pay for all hours worked in excess of forty hours. For an employee who is paid a fixed salary for fluctuating hours and who is employed by an employer a majority of whose business in New Mexico consists of providing investigative services to the federal government, the hourly rate may be calculated in accordance with the provisions of the federal Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 and the regulations pursuant to that act;

1 2 provided that in no case shall the hourly rate be less than the federal minimum wage.

E. The state shall pay each person employed by the 3 4 state no less than a minimum wage rate of ten dollars ten cents (\$10.10) per hour and shall be adjusted annually to account for 5 increases in the cost of living as measured by the percentage 6 7 increase as of February of that year over the level as of February of the previous year of the consumer price index for 8 9 all urban consumers as published by the United States department of labor. The minimum wage shall not be adjusted 10 downward as a result of a decrease in the cost of living. 11 12 F. Any contractor of a contract, which takes effect on or after July 1, 2014, that is with a state agency and that 13 is valued at greater than sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) 14 shall pay each person employed under that contract no less than 15 a minimum wage rate of ten dollars ten cents (\$10.10) per hour 16 and shall be adjusted annually to account for increases in the 17 cost of living as measured by the percentage increase as of 18 February of that year over the level as of February of the 19 previous year of the consumer price index for all urban 20 consumers as published by the United States department of 21 labor. The minimum wage shall not be adjusted downward as a 22

result of a decrease in the cost of living."

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2014.
