SUMMARY

Synopsis of HJC Amendment

The House Judiciary Committee amendment removes the repeal date from Laws 2010, Chapter 7, Section 4 which relates to magistrate court operations funds and fees.

Synopsis of Original Bill

Senate Bill 84 will extend expiration of the collection of the \$4 magistrate court operations fee assessed on penalty assessment misdemeanors from 2014 to 2019 and make revenue generated by operations fees non-reverting.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The magistrate court operations fee generated \$535 thousand in fiscal year 2013. This revenue was used by the AOC to pay lease costs for magistrate courts statewide.

RELATIONSHIP

The recommendation for the AOC in the General Appropriations Act includes \$530 thousand in the base budget of the magistrate court program from magistrate court operations fee revenue.

WHAT WILL BE THE CONSEQUENCES OF NOT ENACTING THIS BILL

If not enacted, collection of the magistrate operations fee will be discontinued on May 31, 2014 and the AOC will be forced to absorb a \$530 thousand revenue decrease in the magistrate court program, a reduction of 1.7 percent.
