15 language and hearing impairments that can limit academic
16 achievement, career advancement and social adjustment for those
17 who do not receive effective treatment; and

18 WHEREAS, these communication disorders can be present at
19 birth or can be caused through accidental injury or illness at
20 any age; and

21 WHEREAS, one in ten New Mexico families is affected by
22 communication disorders; and

23 WHEREAS, those affected deserve access to quality
24 treatment and every opportunity to lead full and productive
25 lives; and
