17	SECTION 1. Section 22-8-29 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967,
18	Chapter 16, Section 78, as amended) is amended to read:
19	"22-8-29. TRANSPORTATION DISTRIBUTIONSREPORTS

21	A. Prior to [November] <u>December</u> 15 of each year,
22	each local school board of a school district and governing body
23	of a state-chartered charter school shall report to the state
24	transportation director, upon forms furnished by the state
25	transportation director, the following information concerning
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1 the school district's or state-chartered charter school's 2 operation on the [first] second reporting date of the current 3 year: the number and designation of school bus 4 (1)5 routes in operation in the school district; (2) the number of miles traveled by each 6 7 school bus on each school bus route, showing the route mileage in accordance with the type of road surface traveled; 8 9 (3) the number of students, including special education students, transported on the [first] second reporting 10 date of the current year [and adjusted for special education 11 12 students on December 1]; the projected number of students to be (4) 13 14 transported in the next school year; the seating capacity, age and mileage of 15 (5) each bus used in the school district for student 16 transportation; and 17 the number of total miles traveled for (6) 18 19 each school district's or state-chartered charter school's per 20 capita feeder routes. Β. Each local school board of a school district and 21 governing body of a state-chartered charter school maintaining 22 a school bus route shall make further reports to the state 23 transportation director at other times specified by the state 24 transportation director. 25 .194937B.3 - 2 -

The state transportation director shall certify 2 to the secretary that the allocations from the transportation distributions to each school district and state-chartered 3 charter school are based upon the transportation distribution 4 formula established in the Public School Code, [The allocations 5 for the first six months of a school year shall be based upon 6 7 the tentative transportation budget of the school district or state-chartered charter school for the current fiscal year. 8 <u>Allocations to a school district or state-chartered charter</u> 9 school for the remainder of the school year shall adjust the 10 amount received by the school district or state-chartered 11 12 charter school so that it equals the amount the school district or state-chartered charter school is entitled to receive for 13 the entire school year based upon the November 15 report] 14 calculated and distributed for the entire school year using the 15 amounts reported on the second reporting date of the prior 16 school year, and subject to audit and verification. 17 D. If, upon determination of the state 18 transportation director, the number of students reported on the 19 20 second reporting date pursuant to Paragraph (3) of Subsection A 21

of this section grew over the number of students from the second reporting date of the prior year, the state transportation director, with approval of the secretary, may transfer an amount from the transportation emergency fund to the local school board of a school district or governing body
