A person who knowingly violates a provision of C. this section is guilty of a misdemeanor, which is punishable pursuant to Section 31-19-1 NMSA 1978.

APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred thousand dollars SECTION 2. (\$100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the New Mexico livestock board for expenditure in fiscal year 2015 to enforce the provisions in law for regulating the transport of horses for slaughter for human consumption. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2015 shall revert to the general fund.
