15	SECTION 1. Section 22-8-29.6 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1995,
16	Chapter 208, Section 15) is amended to read:
17	"22-8-29.6. TRANSPORTATION EMERGENCY FUND
18	A. The "transportation emergency fund" is created
19	in the state treasury. Money in the fund shall not revert to
20	the general fund at the end of any fiscal year. Money in the
21	fund is appropriated to the department for the purpose of
22	funding transportation emergencies, including fuel price
23	<u>increases</u> . The [state superintendent] <u>secretary</u> shall make
24	distributions [only] to ensure the safety of students receiving
25	to-and-from transportation services.
