11	RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; PROHIBITING THE ALTERATION OF
12	AIRBAGS; PROHIBITING THE SALE AND INSTALLATION OF COUNTERFEIT
13	OR SUBSTANDARD AIRBAGS; REQUIRING AIRBAGS IN RENTAL VEHICLES OR
14	VEHICLES FOR HIRE; PROHIBITING MISREPRESENTATION WITH RESPECT
15	TO AIRBAGS; PROVIDING PENALTIES.

17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	SECTION 1. A new section of the Motor Vehicle Code is
19	enacted to read:
20	"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] AIRBAG VIOLATIONS
21	A. It is unlawful for a person to knowingly:
22	(l) fail to install an airbag in a motor
23	vehicle after representing to another person that the person
24	will install an airbag;

1 airbag in a motor vehicle; 2 (3) make or sell a counterfeit or substandard 3 airbag to be installed in a motor vehicle; represent to another that a counterfeit 4 (4) airbag is not counterfeit or that a substandard airbag is not 5 substandard; 6 7 (5) intentionally alter an airbag in a manner that causes the airbag to become a counterfeit or substandard 8 9 airbag; sell a motor vehicle that is known by the 10 (6) seller at the time of the sale to have a counterfeit or 11 12 substandard airbag installed without first warning the purchaser in writing of the counterfeit airbag or the 13 14 substandard airbag; rent or offer for hire a motor vehicle (7) 15 that is not equipped with airbags required to be in the motor 16 vehicle by the applicable federal safety regulations for the 17 make, model and year of the vehicle; or 18 19 (8) assist another in violating the provisions of this subsection with the intent that the crime be committed. 20 A conviction pursuant to this section is a Β. 21 misdemeanor, and the offender shall be sentenced pursuant to 22 the provisions of Section 31-19-1 NMSA 1978. 23 C. 1 and the offender shall be sentenced pursuant to the provisions of Section 31-18-15 NMSA 1978. 2 This section shall not apply to airbags, 3 D. counterfeit airbags or substandard airbags in a motor vehicle 4 operated solely on a closed course or track. 5 As used in this section: 6 Ε. 7 (1)"airbag" means a motor vehicle inflatable occupant restraint system, including all of its component 8 9 parts, such as sensors, controllers, inflators and wiring, 10 that: operates in the event of a crash; 11 (a) 12 and is designed in accordance with (b) 13 federal motor vehicle safety standards for the specific make, 14 model and year of the motor vehicle in which it is or will be 15 installed: 16 "counterfeit airbag" means an airbag that 17 (2) is inoperable or does not meet applicable original equipment 18 manufacturer specifications for an airbag designed to be 19 20 installed in a motor vehicle of a particular make, model and year or displays a mark identical or similar to the genuine 21 mark of the motor vehicle manufacturer without authorization of 22 the motor vehicle manufacturer; 23 "great bodily harm" means an injury to a (3) 24 person that creates a high probability of death, that causes 25

8	provide protection and performance to occupants of the motor
9	vehicle in which it is installed and that is substantially
10	similar to that provided by the airbag originally installed in
11	the motor vehicle."
