16	SECTION 1. Section 34-7-14 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1923,
17	Chapter 29, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:
18	"34-7-14. FEES OF PROBATE COURT CLERKSClerks of the
19	probate courts are entitled to receive the following docket
20	fees in all matters:
21	A. for docketing each cause, to be paid by the
22	party docketing the cause, [thirty dollars (\$30.00)] <u>thirty-</u>
23	five dollars (\$35.00), which shall include all costs of the
24	clerks in any cause in the court. <u>Five dollars (\$5.00) of the</u>
25	docket fee shall be deposited in the judicial education fund.
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1	<u>All money collected pursuant to this subsection shall be</u>
2	remitted monthly to the state treasurer; and
3	B. a fee of fifteen cents (\$.15) per folio in
4	addition to the docket fee may be charged for any excess of
5	twenty folios in cases where judgments or decrees or orders
6	exceed twenty folios."
7	SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATEThe effective date of the
