1 department to take custody of the child immediately upon 2 receipt of report of the injuries: (1) burns, including cigarette burns, 3 blistering or scalds; 4 (2) bruises that evidence the shape of a body 5 part or an object that caused the bruise; 6 7 (3) multiple bruises, simultaneously present on the face, head, neck or other body part; 8 9 (4) repeated appearance of similar bruises, lacerations, welts or bone fractures; 10 adult-sized bite marks; (5) 11 12 (6) injuries apparently caused by ligatures; multiple types of injuries, simultaneously 13 (7) 14 present on a child's body; multiple similar injuries or bruises, (8) 15 simultaneously present on a child's body, that are in various 16 stages of healing; and 17 (9) any other injury that evidences injuries 18 that can be reasonably believed to be caused by abuse. 19 20 Β. The department shall hold a child who is taken into custody pursuant to Subsection A of this section, and a 21 hearing on the evidence of abuse shall be held within forty-22 eight hours. 23 Following a court's finding of abuse, a child C. 24 who was taken into custody by the department pursuant to 25 .196030.2 - 2 -
