20	"24-1-2. DEFINITIONSAs used in the Public Health Act:
21	A. "department" or "division" means:

"health facility" means a public hospital, profit or nonprofit private hospital, general or special hospital, outpatient facility, maternity home or shelter, adult daycare facility, nursing home, intermediate care facility, boarding home not under the control of an institution of higher learning, child care center, shelter care home, diagnostic and treatment center, rehabilitation center, infirmary, community .196020.1

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1 mental health center that serves both children and adults or 2 adults only, residential treatment center that serves persons up to twenty-one years of age, community mental health center 3 that serves only persons up to twenty-one years of age [and], 4 day treatment center that serves persons up to twenty-one years 5 of age [or], a health service organization operating as a 6 7 freestanding hospice or a home health agency and any other program, including a person, place or program that, for a fee, 8 donation or scholarship, accepts custody, care or control, 9 including temporary guardianship, of children and that provides 10 residence for children for a period that exceeds sixty days in 11 12 a twelve-month period. The designation of these entities as health facilities is only for the purposes of definition in the 13 Public Health Act and does not imply that a free-standing 14 hospice or a home health agency is considered a health facility 15 for the purposes of other provisions of state or federal laws. 16 "Health facility" also includes those facilities that, by 17 federal regulation, must be licensed by the state to obtain or 18 maintain full or partial, permanent or temporary federal 19 [Health facility" does not include the offices 20 funding. and treatment rooms of licensed private practitioners; and 21
