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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	SECTION 1. A new section of the Economic Development
18	Department Act is enacted to read:
19	"[ <u>NEW MATERIAL</u> ] DIGITAL MEDIA ACCELERATORThe secretary
20	shall establish the "digital media accelerator" as a business
21	development program for digital media small businesses, with
22	the goal of producing a trained work force and jobs in the
23	digital media industry. The digital media accelerator shall
24	provide technical assistance, consulting, mentoring, business
25	training, marketing assistance and networking opportunities to

SECTION 2. A new section of the Economic Development Department Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] DIGITAL MEDIA ACCELERATOR REVOLVING FUND.--The "digital media accelerator revolving fund" is 8 created in the state treasury. The fund consists of payments from digital media accelerator clients, appropriations, gifts, grants, donations, bequests, income from investment of the fund and money otherwise accruing to the fund. Money in the fund 12 shall not revert to any other fund at the end of a fiscal year. The department shall administer the fund, and money in the fund is appropriated to the department to provide for the maintenance, operation and expansion of the digital media accelerator. Money in the fund shall be disbursed on warrants signed by the secretary of finance and administration pursuant 18 to vouchers signed by the secretary of economic development or the secretary's authorized representative."

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2014.
