16	SECTION 1. TEMPORARY PROVISIONLEGISLATIVE FINDINGS
17	WAIVER OF REQUIREMENTSThe legislature finds that the recent
18	adoption of common core content standards in public schools
19	requires a marked shift in curriculum and instruction methods,
20	more stringent requirements for passing standards-based
21	assessments and higher stakes for teachers and school leaders,
22	including employment consequences such as termination based on
23	the results of standards-based assessments. The legislature
24	also finds that, although teachers and school leaders have had
25	insufficient time to receive adequate training and school
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1 districts have had insufficient time to adequately train 2 teachers and school leaders on the newly adopted common core content standards and to ensure alignment of curriculum and 3 4 instruction under the common core content standards with 5 standards-based assessments, teacher and school leader evaluations are required by public education department rules 6 7 to be based to a significant degree upon student performance on standards-based assessments despite an inadequate transition 8 9 period. For the 2013-2014 school year, teachers and school leaders shall not be evaluated pursuant to any evaluation 10 system established in rule or law after January 1, 2011. 11 12 SECTION 2.
