15	SECTION 1. Section 12-11-24 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1955,
16	Chapter 185, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:
17	"12-11-24. PROVISIONAL APPROPRIATIONFor the purposes
18	set out in Section $[6-7-1]$ <u>12-11-23</u> NMSA 1978, when and if the
19	governor [shall declare] <u>declares</u> an emergency, as provided in
20	Section [6-7-3] <u>12-11-25</u> NMSA 1978, [there is appropriated the

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declaration of [such] the emergency [or emergencies]."

2 SECTION 2. Section 12-11-25 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1955, 3 Chapter 185, Section 3, as amended) is amended to read: "12-11-25. EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS--MANNER.--The money 4 5 appropriated by Sections [6-7-1 and 6-7-2] 12-11-23 and 12-11-24 NMSA 1978 shall be expended for disaster relief for 6 7 any disaster declared by the governor to be of such magnitude 8 as to be beyond local control and requiring the resources of 9 the state. The funds shall be expended by the governor or 10 [any] an agent or agency designated by [him] the governor for those purposes, either as a state project or for securing 11 12 matching federal funds. The money shall be paid out upon warrants drawn by the secretary of finance and administration 13 14 upon vouchers approved by the governor or an agent or agency designated by [him] the governor for that purpose. As used in 15 this section, "state project" means an expenditure by a state 16 agency to provide those resources and services necessary to 17 18 avoid or minimize economic or physical harm until a situation 19 becomes stabilized and again under local self-support and 20 control. "State project" may include any expenditure on a temporary, emergency basis for lodging, sheltering, health 21 care, food, any transportation or shipping necessary to protect 22 lives or public property; or for any other action necessary to 23 protect the public health, safety and welfare." 24
