16	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONOne hundred fifty thousand
17	dollars (\$150,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
18	local government division of the department of finance and
19	administration for expenditure in fiscal year 2015 to allow
20	Taos county to contract with a community organization to
21	provide economic development programs that will include courses
22	on food manufacturing, food preservation, nutrition, gardening,
23	raising livestock and management of agricultural businesses.
24	Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
25	fiscal year 2015 shall revert to the general fund.
