18	2015Notwithstanding the budget adjustment authority provided
19	in the General Appropriation Act of 2014, an executive agency
20	shall not transfer money out of personal services and employee
21	benefits. At the end of fiscal year 2015, money in an
22	executive agency's personal services and employee benefits
23	shall not revert to the general fund but shall be distributed
24	to all of the agency's full-time-equivalent employees that are
25	employed on July 1, 2015 and that were employed during fiscal
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	1	year 2015 in equal shares, prorated by the number of pay
	2	periods worked. The distribution provided in this section is
	3	effective the first pay period after July 1, 2015.
	4	SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATEThe effective date of the
	5	provisions of this act is July 1, 2014.
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
