AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYEES; RAISING THE MINIMUM WAGE FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE STATE AND STATE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 10-7-9 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1974, Chapter 10, Section 2) is amended to read:

"10-7-9. MINIMUM SALARY RATE.--Every state employee and every person regularly employed at a state educational institution named in Article 12, Section 11 of the constitution of New Mexico [constitution], except student employees as defined by the [board of educational finance] higher education department, shall receive a salary [at a rate equal to at least four hundred dollars (\$400) per month] calculable at no less than ten dollars ten cents (\$10.10) per hour."
