

1 A MEMORIAL

2 DECLARING FEBRUARY 5, 2014 AS "MOLINA DAY" IN THE SENATE.

4 WHEREAS, Molina healthcare of New Mexico was founded
5 thirty years ago by Dr. C. David Molina, an emergency room
6 physician who opened a medical clinic to serve the patients
7 he frequently treated in the emergency room simply because
8 they did not have a primary care doctor to care for them; and

9 WHEREAS, from that clinic, Molina healthcare of
10 New Mexico continued to grow over the next three decades to
11 become a fortune 500, multistate health care organization
12 that provides government-sponsored health care programs; and

13 WHEREAS, the company has evolved over the years, but the
14 mission has remained the same: to provide those most in need
15 with access to high-quality health care programs; and

16 WHEREAS, this mission is still carried out today by the
17 founder's children, Dr. J. Mario Molina, president and chief
18 executive officer; John C. Molina, chief financial officer;
19 and Dr. Martha Molina Bernadett, executive vice president;
20 and

21 WHEREAS, Patty Kehoe is the president of Molina
22 healthcare of New Mexico's subsidiary and was promoted to her
23 current position in January 2013; and

24 WHEREAS, Molina healthcare of New Mexico serves
25 approximately one hundred seventy-two thousand New Mexicans,

1 and it recently opened clinics in Santa Fe and Albuquerque;
2 and

3 WHEREAS, the Molina healthcare of New Mexico network
4 comprises approximately one thousand five hundred primary
5 care physicians and six thousand five hundred specialists,
6 and it is affiliated with approximately seventy hospitals in
7 New Mexico; and

8 WHEREAS, Molina healthcare of New Mexico is ranked the
9 number one medicaid health plan in New Mexico;

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE
11 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that February 5, 2014 be declared
12 "Molina Day" in the senate; and

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be
14 transmitted to Molina healthcare of New Mexico. _____
