

1 A MEMORIAL
2 DESIGNATING "THE BREWERY DISTRICT" IN ALBUQUERQUE.

4 WHEREAS, the creation of local brews is an exciting
5 cultural phenomenon found in cities nationwide; and

6 WHEREAS, New Mexico boasts over three dozen established
7 microbreweries and brew pubs dotting scenic byways and main
8 streets across the state; and

9 WHEREAS, microbrewers and distilleries are becoming an
10 important part of New Mexico's small business economy; and

11 WHEREAS, the establishment and growth of local
12 microbreweries has a revitalization effect on surrounding
13 neighborhoods, bringing communities together, bolstering
14 local pride and creating local jobs; and

15 WHEREAS, while the entire state is an excellent location
16 for microbreweries and distilleries, a particular area in
17 Albuquerque is home to four such businesses; and

18 WHEREAS, Nexus, La Cumbre, Left Turn Distilling and
19 Il Vicino breweries are located in and around the region to
20 the north of Candelaria road, west of the north diversion
21 channel, east of interstate 25 and south of Jefferson street;
22 and

23 WHEREAS, these four businesses already create an
24 informal "cluster" of brewery businesses where managers and
25 customers enjoy the proximity of the four businesses; and

1 WHEREAS, this area has become a popular destination for
2 New Mexicans seeking to enjoy, and to work for,
3 microbreweries;

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE
5 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the Albuquerque area in and around
6 the region north of Candelaria road, west of the north
7 diversion channel, east of interstate 25 and south of
8 Jefferson street be referred to and branded as "the brewery
9 district"; and

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
11 transmitted to the owners of Nexus, La Cumbre, Left Turn
12 Distilling and Il Vicino breweries. _____
