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1 dependents of members of the [New Mexico] national guard of New 2 Mexico have been left without adequate financial resources when 3 a national guard member has been killed while on active duty; members of the [New Mexico] national guard 4 (3) of New Mexico are now being asked to serve extended periods of 5 active duty in combat areas; 6 7 (4) members of the [New Mexico] national guard of New Mexico are eligible for life insurance policies that are 8 9 currently limited to [two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000)] four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) through 10 the federal servicemembers' group life insurance program; and 11 12 (5) members of the [New Mexico] national guard of New Mexico provide New Mexico and its citizens valuable 13 14 benefits through their service inside this state and through their recently extended periods of active duty in combat areas 15 outside of New Mexico, and in exchange for these extended 16 periods of active duty they should receive assistance with 17 their premiums for the federal servicemembers' group life 18 19 insurance program. 20 Β. The purpose of creating and funding the service members' life insurance reimbursement fund is to provide a 21 benefit to members of the [New Mexico] national guard of New 22 <u>Mexico</u> in exchange for and in recognition of their assumption 23 of extended periods of active duty in combat areas, in addition 24 to their increased contributions to the safety and welfare of 25 .198772.2SA

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
