11 RELATING TO COUNTY EMPLOYEES; ADJUSTING THE QUALIFICATION
12 INCENTIVE PAY FOR APPRAISERS.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 SECTION 1. Section 4-39-5 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1977,
16 Chapter 138, Section 2) is amended to read:

17 "4-39-5. ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION TO APPRAISERS.--A board
18 of county commissioners may provide [~~as qualification incentive~~
19 ~~pay the following~~] additional cumulative increments to the
20 salary of any qualifying appraiser employed in the office of
21 the assessor as an incentive for obtaining greater
22 qualification levels up to the following amounts:

23 A. an additional five hundred dollars (\$500) a year
24 for holding an "Appraiser 1" certificate;

25 B. an additional [~~one thousand dollars (\$1,000)]~~

1 one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) a year for holding
2 an "Appraiser 2" certificate;

5 an "Appraiser 3" certificate; and

6 D. an additional [~~one thousand dollars (\$1,000)~~]
7 three thousand dollars (\$3,000) a year for holding an
8 "Appraiser 4" certificate."

9 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the
10 provisions of this act is July 1, 2015.
