17	SECTION 1. A new section of the Unfair Practices Act is
18	enacted to read:
19	"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] DECEPTIVELY LABELED PRODUCTSSYNTHETIC
20	DRUGSPROHIBITION
21	A. A person shall not sell a product for which a
22	specific intended use is provided by the product's label,
23	packaging or instructions, and which use is not the production
24	of an altered state, when the person knows or reasonably should
25	know that the product is primarily used contrary to the
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specific intended use to produce an altered state through
introduction into the human body.

In addition to any other applicable civil or 3 Β. criminal violations, a violation of Subsection A of this 4 5 section shall constitute an unfair or deceptive trade practice. For the purpose of this section, a person shall have committed 6 7 a violation of the Unfair Practices Act for every individually packaged product that the person sells in violation of 8 Subsection A of this section. 9 For the purpose of this section: 10 C. "altered state" means a person's 11 (1)12 experience of a depressant, stimulant, hallucinogenic or narcotic effect; and 13 "sell" means display for sale, distribute, 14 (2)dispense, offer for sale, attempt to sell or sell." 15 EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the SECTION 2. 16 provisions of this act is July 1, 2015. 17 - 2 -18 19

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
