AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMINAL SENTENCING; INCREASING THE PENALTY FOR ESCAPE FROM CUSTODY OF THE CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 30-22-11.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993, Chapter 121, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

"30-22-11.1. ESCAPE FROM THE CUSTODY OF THE CHILDREN,
YOUTH AND FAMILIES DEPARTMENT--ESCAPE FROM JUVENILE
DETENTION.--Escape from the custody of the children, youth and
families department consists of any person who has been
adjudicated as a delinquent child and has been committed
lawfully to the custody of a department juvenile justice
facility or who is alleged to be a delinquent child and has
been lawfully detained in a juvenile detention facility:

escaping or attempting to escape from another lawful place of custody or confinement that is not within the confines of a children, youth and families department juvenile justice facility.

Any person who commits escape from the custody of a children, youth and families department juvenile justice facility is guilty of a [misdemeanor] fourth degree felony."

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2015.

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
