E. The division may assess a fine, not to exceed
two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) for violation of the
provisions of this section or rules adopted in accordance with
this section. Fines shall be credited to the current school
fund as provided in Article 12, Section 4 of the constitution
of New Mexico.
