AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION; REQUIRING SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND  
INDIVIDUAL PUBLIC SCHOOLS TO ESTABLISH STANDARDS IMPLEMENTATION  
LEADERSHIP TEAMS TO MANAGE IMPLEMENTATION OF STATE-ADOPTED  
COLLEGE AND CAREER READINESS STANDARDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

**SECTION 1.** A new section of the Assessment and  
Accountability Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] STANDARDS IMPLEMENTATION LEADERSHIP  
TEAMS--ESTABLISHMENT--IMPLEMENTATION OF STANDARDS.--

A. As used in this section, "school district"  
includes a locally chartered or state-chartered charter school.

B. Each school district and each individual public  
school within a school district shall establish a "standards  
implementation leadership team", which shall consist of school

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1 administrators and teachers.

2 C. The standards implementation leadership team  
3 shall provide leadership to manage the process for  
4 implementation of state-adopted college and career readiness  
5 standards, including the following:

6 (1) developing methodologies to move the  
7 school staff from awareness to implementation of the state-  
8 adopted standards and to ensure that staff members understand  
9 them;

10 (2) providing for a way in which teachers are  
11 allowed to share their perspectives and pedagogical strategies  
12 with each other as they learn about and implement the state-  
13 adopted standards;

14 (3) gathering both qualitative and  
15 quantitative data about the progress of implementation,  
16 questions that arise and the types of support needed by  
17 teachers; and

18 (4) ensuring that the implementation of the  
19 state-adopted standards takes into consideration the needs of  
20 the staff and student population of the school."

21 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**--The effective date of the  
22 provisions of this act is July 1, 2015.

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
