20	A. Upon the filing of a petition for order of
21	protection, the court shall:
22	(1) immediately grant an ex parte temporary
23	order of protection without bond if there is probable cause

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1 domestic abuse has occurred; and

2 cause the temporary order of protection (2) 3 together with notice of hearing to be served immediately on the alleged perpetrator of the domestic abuse; [and 4 (3) within ten days after the granting of the 5 temporary order of protection, hold a hearing on the question 6 7 of continuing the order;] or [(4)] (3) if an exparte order is not granted, 8 9 serve notice to appear upon the parties and hold a hearing on the petition for order of protection within seventy-two hours 10 after the filing of the petition; provided if notice of hearing 11 12 cannot be served within seventy-two hours, the temporary order of protection shall be automatically extended for ten days. 13

B. If the court grants a temporary order ofprotection:

(1) it may award temporary custody and visitation of any children involved when appropriate;

(2) it shall hold a hearing on the question of <u>continuing the order; and</u>

(3) no later than sixty days after service of the temporary order of protection, the court shall either enter a permanent order of protection or dismiss the temporary order of protection.

C. Except for petitions alleging stalking or sexual assault, if the court finds that the alleged perpetrator is not .198671.2 - 2 -

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	1	a household member, the court shall dismiss the petition."
