2	RECOGNIZING THE SUBMARINE USS ALBUQUERQUE AND HER		
3	THIRTY-THREE YEARS OF DISTINGUISHED SERVICE TO THE UNITED		
4	STATES AND ITS NAVY.

6	WHEREAS, the USS Albuquerque (SSN-706) is a		
7	Los Angeles-class, nuclear-powered, fast-attack submarine		
8	named after the city of Albuquerque, New Mexico; and		
9	WHEREAS, during her service life, the USS Albuquerque		
10	steamed well over one-half million miles, made well over one		
11	thousand dives, made goodwill port calls in eighteen		
12	countries and completed over fifteen overseas deployments,		
13	ranging from three to seven months in duration, from the		
14	north Atlantic to the Mediterranean to the Arabian sea to		
15	the west Pacific; and		
16	WHEREAS, since commissioning on May 21, 1983, a total		
17	of thirteen commanding officers guided the USS Albuquerque		
18	through her thirty-three years of active duty; and		
19	WHEREAS, the USS Albuquerque is known as the		
20	"Sure Shooter of the Submarine Force", having established		
21	the best hit rate by firing ten tomahawk missiles at targets		
22	in Serb-controlled Yugoslavia in May 1999; and		
23	WHEREAS, the USS Albuquerque is one of the very first		
24	nuclear-powered attack submarines to earn the distinction of		
25	combat veteran; and

WHEREAS, the submarine has brought great pride to the city of Albuquerque through her participation in operation 3 Iraqi freedom and her distinguished service in the global war on terrorism; and 4 WHEREAS, the USS Albuquerque has completed several 6 highly classified missions that not all United States 7 submarines can perform; and

8 WHEREAS, the USS Albuquerque has won four annual battle 9 efficiency "E" awards for the most proficient submarine crew 10 in her squadron, plus three meritorious unit commendations 11 and a navy unit commendation in recognition of sustained 12 superior technical performance and continual combat 13 readiness: and

14 WHEREAS, her 2001-2003 refueling cycle was the fastest 15 ever at twenty months and the least expensive, saving nearly 16 twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000), both while setting new 17 safety and training records, followed by the best 18 post-overhaul performance and the most successful ever 19 combat systems modernization; and

20 WHEREAS, during an around-the-world deployment in 21 August 2009 that included changing her home port from 22 Groton, Connecticut, to San Diego, California, the USS 23 Albuquerque became the submarine that completed the navy's 24 split of submarine force assets, sixty percent in the 25 Pacific, forty percent in the Atlantic; and

2	long-standing, mutually beneficial relationship with its	
3	namesake city, with continuous support for the officers and	
4	crew by the greater Albuquerque chamber of commerce and the	
5	navy league New Mexico council; and	
6	WHEREAS, a community initiative has begun to acquire	
7	the submarine sail as the centerpiece for a planned USS	
8	Albuquerque memorial after decommissioning, scheduled for	
9	late 2015;	
10	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE	
11	STATE OF NEW MEXICO that sincere gratitude be expressed to	
12	the hundreds of submariners who have served with pride and	
13	distinction aboard the USS Albuquerque during the past	
14	thirty-three years; and

16	be transmitted to the commanding officer of the USS
