1 2 REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR TO DECLARE OCTOBER 22, 2015 "DAY OF 3 CONCERN ABOUT YOUNG PEOPLE AND GUN VIOLENCE". 4 5 WHEREAS, the young people of New Mexico are its most 6 valuable resource, and the community has a vested interest in ensuring that children grow up in an environment free from 7 fear and violence; and 8 WHEREAS, young people deserve a voice in the issues that 9 affect them and their futures; and 10 WHEREAS, in the past thirty years, one hundred sixteen 11 thousand three hundred eighty-five children and teens have 12 been killed by firearms, and between 1997 and 2009, 13 hospitalizations from gunshot wounds increased from four 14 15 thousand two hundred seventy to nearly eight thousand; and WHEREAS, the student pledge against gun violence affords 16 the opportunity for bringing together school boards and their 17 respective school districts, as well as networks and 18 resources throughout New Mexico, to build on existing efforts 19 to address issues of gun violence; and 20 WHEREAS, since its inception, more than ten million 21 students nationwide have signed the student pledge against 22

WHEREAS, the Santa Fe public school district and other 24 state school districts have established a district-wide 25
