SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

HB 538 requires the Construction Industries Division (CID) of RLD to develop and adopt rules requiring baby diaper changing stations in both men's and women's restroom facilities in a place of public accommodations being newly constructed or public facilities undergoing substantial renovations of their restrooms that exceeds \$10 thousand dollars. HB 538 allows CID to assess a fine of up to \$250 for violations of this provision. All fines shall be credited to the current school fund.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

CID's workload, in regards to building inspections, would virtually remain the same as this would just now be another item to inspect while on site. CID will incur administrative costs for the proposed rulemaking.
