SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Memorial 127 requests that NMDOT study the costs to the state and local governments of maintaining and operating the rail runner over the next twenty years, the feasibility of selling the track, rolling stock and other rail runner assets, and the potential benefits of replacing the rail runner with a reestablished commuter bus service. The memorial also requests DOT present the study results to the appropriate interim legislative committee prior to November 15, 2015.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There is no appropriation to cover costs of completing the study so DOT would pay the costs out of the existing operating budget. DOT states that, to complete the study, they would utilize existing staff and budgeted funds. DOT anticipates that contractual assistance would be required for some elements of the studies at a likely cost of \$60,000 or less.
