SUMMARY

Synopsis of SCONC Amendment:

The Senate Conservation Committee (SCONC) amendment to Senate Bill 82 to clarifies it is unlawful to locate a protected species with the intent of using such information for hunting purposes.

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 82 would make it unlawful to use a drone to pursue, harass, drive or rally, spot or locate a protected species or to relay the location of a protected species to another person by any means of communication or signaling device.

The bill defines "drone" as a device used or designed for navigation or flight in the air that is unmanned and guided remotely or by a computer or control system that is on board the drone.
