Synopsis of Bill

Senate Memorial 116 requests that the Attorney General investigate whether the state's law enforcement agencies have established procedures required under the Prohibition of Profiling Practices Act (PPPA) and whether law enforcement agencies have engaged in the use of excessive violence and biased based policing. The memorial also requests that the Attorney General publish the report contemplated in the PPPA; report the number and status of complaints submitted to law enforcement agencies; and, that an interim legislative committee address a perceived lack of action on the part of certain law enforcement agencies to comply with the PPPA.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There would be a cost associated with conducting the proposed investigation and publishing the report.
