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19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
20	SECTION 1. Section 7-1-6.18 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1987,
21	Chapter 257, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

23	CEMETERY FUND[Upon a certification by the state board of
24	finance that the city of Santa Fe grants and conveys additional

Section 7-2-28 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1987, Chapter 257, Section 3, as amended) is amended to read: 10 "7-2-28. OPTIONAL DESIGNATION OF TAX REFUND 11 12 CONTRIBUTION .--Any individual whose state income tax liability 13 Α. 14 in any year is lower than the amount of money held by the department to the credit of such individual for that tax year 15 may designate any portion of the income tax refund due to be 16 17 paid into the veterans' [national] state cemetery fund. In the 18 case of a joint return, both individuals must make such 19 designation. 20 Β. The secretary shall revise the state income tax form to allow the designation by individual taxpayers of such 21 contributions in substantially the following form: 22

"New Mexico Veterans' [National] <u>State</u> Cemetery Fund--Check [] if you wish to contribute a part or all of your tax refund to the Veterans' [National] <u>State</u> Cemetery .202997.1

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Fund. Enter here \$_____ the amount of your contribution.".

C. The provisions of this section do not apply to refund amounts intercepted under the Tax Refund Intercept Program Act, and any designation under the provisions of this section with respect to such intercepted refunds is void."

SECTION 3. Section 7-2-28.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2011, Chapter 42, Section 1) is amended to read:

9 "7-2-28.1. VETERANS' [NATIONAL] STATE CEMETERY FUND--CREATED.--The "veterans' [national] state cemetery fund" is 10 11 created as a nonreverting fund in the state treasury. The fund 12 consists of appropriations, gifts, grants, donations and 13 amounts designated pursuant to Section 7-2-28 NMSA 1978. Money 14 in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not revert to any 15 other fund. The veterans' services department shall administer the fund, and money in the fund is appropriated to the 16 veterans' services department [to carry out the intent of 17 18 Section 7-2-27 NMSA 1978]."

SECTION 4. REPEAL.--Section 7-2-27 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1987, Chapter 257, Section 2) is repealed.

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
