[NEW MATERIAL] FORFEITURE OF SERVICE CREDIT 22 UPON CONVICTION .--23 Α. If a member or a retired member of a retirement 24 act pension plan is convicted of a campaign offense or a public 25

corruption offense, all service credit earned by the member or
 retired member shall be forfeited.

Upon a member's or retired member's conviction 3 Β. for a campaign offense or a public corruption offense, the 4 court shall enter an order of forfeiture that directs the 5 public employees retirement association or the educational 6 7 retirement board to terminate all benefit payments to the member or retired member and, subject to relevant court orders, 8 9 to refund any remaining accumulated member contributions, with interest, to the member or retired member. 10

C. The court shall stay the order of forfeiture provided for in Subsection B of this section, pending disposition of:

(1) a direct appeal of the conviction; or

(2) a dissolution of marriage or a child support matter that was filed prior to the member's or retired member's conviction.

D. The court shall not stay the order of forfeiture provided for in Subsection B of this section pending disposition of a petition for writ of habeas corpus or for other post-conviction relief.

E. If the convicted member or retired member is subsequently pardoned, the forfeiture provided for in this section and the refund of the member's or retired member's accumulated member contributions shall be regarded as a
