18	SECTION 1. [<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] SHORT TITLEThis act may be

"entry fee" means cash or cash equivalent that 2 is required to be paid by a fantasy contest player to a fantasy 3 contest operator to participate in a fantasy contest; "fantasy contest" means a fantasy or simulated 4 C. 5 game or contest in which: the value of all prizes and awards offered 6 (1)7 to winning players is established and made known to the players in advance of the contest: 8 9 (2) all winning outcomes reflect the relative knowledge and skill of the players and are determined 10 predominantly by accumulated statistical results of the 11 12 performance of individuals, including athletes in the case of sporting events; and 13 14 (3) winning outcomes are not based on the score, point spread or any performance of any single actual 15 sports team or combination of such teams or solely on any 16 single performance of an individual athlete in any single 17 actual sporting event; 18 "fantasy contest operator" means a person or 19 D. 20 entity that offers fantasy contests with an entry fee for a cash prize to the general public; and 21 Ε. 1 A fantasy contest operator shall implement Α. 2 procedures for fantasy contests with an entry fee that are intended to: 3 (1) prevent employees of the fantasy contest 4 operator, and relatives living in the same household as such 5 employees, from competing in any such public fantasy contests 6 7 offered by any fantasy contest operator in which the operator 8 offers a cash prize; 9 (2) prevent sharing of confidential information that could affect such fantasy contest play with 10 third parties until the information is made publicly available; 11 12 (3) prevent the fantasy contest operator from participating in such a fantasy contest he or she offers; 13 (4) verify that a fantasy contest player in 14 such a fantasy contest is eighteen years of age or older; 15 (5) ensure that individuals who participate or 16 officiate in a game or contest that is the subject of such a 17 fantasy contest will be restricted from entering such a fantasy 18 contest that is determined, in whole or in part, on the 19 accumulated statistical results of a team of individuals in a 20 game or contest in which he or she is a player; 21 (6) allow individuals to restrict themselves 22 from entering such a fantasy contest upon request and provide 23 reasonable steps to prevent the person from entering such 24 fantasy contests offered by the fantasy contest operator; 25

(8) segregate fantasy contest player funds from operational funds and maintain a reserve in the form of cash, cash equivalents, an irrevocable letter or credit, a bond or a combination thereof, in the amount of the deposits made to the accounts of fantasy contest players for the benefit and protection of the funds held in such accounts.

B. A fantasy contest operator offering fantasy contests with an entry fee in this state shall contract with a third party to annually perform an independent audit, consistent with the standards established by the public company accounting oversight board, to ensure compliance with this section and submit the results of such audit to the secretary of state.

SECTION 4. [<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] PENALTIES.--A person, firm, corporation, association, agent or employee who violates the Fantasy Contests Act is subject to a civil penalty of not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for each violation, which shall accrue to the state and may be recovered in a civil action brought by the secretary of state.

SECTION 5. [<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] EXEMPTION.--Fantasy contests, as defined in Section 2 of the Fantasy Contests Act, are exempt .203636.2ms
